

SAMPLE PLAYFAIR SEASON

This sample is based on a 12 week program. Determine the right length of season for your circumstances. This will offer a rough guideline for running a Playfair Team.

1. WEEK 1 - PREPARATION

- Make presentations to staff to solicit Teacher Facilitators
- Develop student recruitment strategy
- Prepare notices for parents and students outlining program
- Initiate contact with Community Mentor for Disability
- Contact other local schools involved with Playfair to schedule a Playfair Celebration for the end of the season

2. WEEK 2-3 - TEAM RECRUITMENT

- Make announcements and class presentations to solicit members
- Hold information meeting and send home Consent Form
- Have students & parents commit by returning Consent Form
- Schedule first team meeting

3. WEEKS 3-4 – EDUCATION

- Hold meetings and discussions on issues of Disability, Social Justice and Inclusion
- Introduce team members to Community Mentor for Disability and get their perspective on issues they've faced
- Use *WHY JOIN PLAYFAIR?* comments on CD to stimulate discussion with students
- Show videos on CD and other videos that may inform students about issues

4. WEEK 5-6 – CREATING ACTIVITIES

- With your team, create and determine your Playfair activities
- Look at the logistics involved in developing and presenting the activity
- Establish timelines and responsibilities for creating the activity

5. WEEK 7-10 – DEVELOP & REHEARSE ACTIVITIES

- Develop, rehearse and fine tune your activity
- Schedule activities in school, with other schools and in the community
- Develop strategies to promote the activity

6. WEEK 11-12 – PLAYFAIR PRESENTATIONS

- This is the season – enjoy your Playfair Presentations
- Conclude the season with a Playfair Celebration with other participating schools
- Hold an end of season party with your team and acknowledge team members with a Playfair Certificate
